I haven't been able to resist this month's AI trend! I love my perfect teeth, but not too sure about the wedding ring!



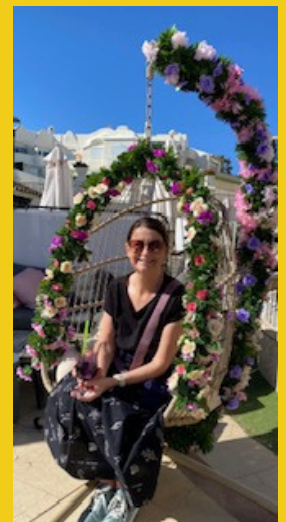
La moda y los coches
